

The €500 net: the Arizona scam!

The government promises “an extra €500 net”... but the reality is quite different.

An illusion of purchasing power

- The measure would not come into effect until 2029 (if it comes into effect at all).
- High earners will benefit much more than low-income earners.
- In practice, it will not even be €500 for the majority of workers. In reality, it will only be €79 per month on average per worker.

What they don't tell you

- Those €500 don't come out of thin air: they come from cuts in social security contributions and taxes.
- Less revenue = fewer resources for:
 - pensions,
 - schools,
 - public healthcare.

If we further weaken social security, tomorrow we will see:

- more privatization,
- less access to healthcare,
- education reserved for those who can pay.

The €500 net, it's a social scam.
