Limiting unemployment benefits over time? An attack on all of us!

The Arizona government wants to exclude up to 174,000 people from unemployment benefits by 2026. This is not reform, it is organized impoverishment.

What this reform means:

- Exclusion of the long-term unemployed, even if they have worked in the meantime
- End of unemployment benefits for people returning to education
- No solutions for workers over 45 who have been laid off
- Targeted cuts for the most vulnerable, while companies pocket \$17.7 billion in subsidies and pay out \$19.2 billion in dividends

The facts:

- 172,000 job vacancies, mainly in Flanders
- 300,000 job seekers receiving benefits
- 500,000 people on long-term sick leave whom the government wants to force back to work
- → There is a shortage of jobs, not a shortage of "motivated" unemployed people!

What the government is planning:

- → A weakened, regionalized social security system
- → A society where only the richest can live with dignity
- → Constant blackmail: "Take any job, or die"

Behind the numbers, real people

Marie, 49, works in a daycare center via ALE vouchers at €4.10/hour. She will be excluded from unemployment benefits in 2026.

Former Cora employees, laid off after 20 years of service: soon to be without income.

Aïcha, a marketing student, soon to be deprived of all benefits.
